

NOTE PAD COVER

Finished Size is 14 1/2 by 19 1/2 inch rectangle

If both front and back are made from scraps, cut 2 pieces of flannel or very lightweight batting at 16 by 21 inches. Completely cover with pieces of fabric. Once covered, cut to size of 14 1/2 by 19 1/2 inches.

Put right sides together in a sandwich, I round the corners to make easier. Sew around entire piece leaving a 6 inch opening for turning. You can also, make a binding and put together using that method.

After stitching around project leaving an opening, turn right side out and press well. I press inside 1/4 seam and pin together. Top stitch entire piece to catch open seam.

Quilt as desired. This is done to hold front and inside together.

Lay piece flat and turn up the 19 1/2 inch edge 3 1/2 inches. Press and pin to hold. Measure in 5 inches and stitch through the turned up edge and the front. Measure over 1 inch and repeat stitching. Move over 5 3/4 inch and sew again. Then move over 1 more inch and sew again.

At this point I like to sew the outside edge on each end a few stitches to hold in place.

Insert notepad into the 5 3/4 inch slot to the right of note pad, fold over right hand edge and fold over left hand edge, making an envelope around note pad and pen. Sew a 1 inch piece of hook and loop tape to the outside the left hand flap and the other side of tape to the inside right flap.

I then like to put buttons or bows or something on the front of the cover.
